- QUESTION 1: We are interested to participate as a firm, but do not yet have a DUNS number/SAM information. Would you be able to provide guidance as to whether it would be possible to participate as a firm without a DUNS number/SAM information?
  - **Applying organizations that do not have a DUNS/SAM number can submit documentation showing that they have applied for a DUNS/SAM number and be considered as a firm, though they would need to receive these before a contract could be signed. Documentation could include confirmation of application for DUNS/SAM in PDF form.**
  
- QUESTION 2: If it would not be possible to participate as a firm without a DUNS number/SAM information, would it be possible to submit a bid/proposal as a group of individuals?
  - **Individuals applying are exempt from the DUNS/SAM requirement.**
