

- Working with National Labs on their Tribal policies & guidance





Critical Minerals Initiative

- Currently: DOE, DOI (BLM, BIA, USGS), EPA, Commerce, Treasury
- Implement Tribal recommendations from Sept 2023 report: Improving Mining on Public Lands
- Create forums for Tribes, industry, NGOs to discuss path forward on domestic critical minerals supply chain
- June Consultation
- Tribes, White House, industry late summer
