# SPECTRUM

- Research interference of unlicensed devices in 6GHz band
- Enlist Departments of Energy and Defense to explore sharing 7 and 8 GHz bands
- Expand utilities' access to additional spectrum bands
  - Work with the International Telecommunications Union and CITEL to
    - advocate for harmonized spectrum allocations

## CYBERSECURITY

 Security is an increasingly critical issue in the face of repeated attacks

101 attacks in the first 8 months of 2022, which doesn't even include the attacks in North Carolina or Washington, both of which left tens of thousands without power

- Just 97 attacks in all of 2021
- UTC continues to address legal and regulatory developments in cybersecurity



### INCREASED REPORTING CONCERNS

- Security agencies now have unprecedented authority to regulate and enforce critical infrastructure
  - Adds to the many other regulatory requirements already in place
  - Concerns that these additional measures will delay our members recovery efforts in the event of a reportable cyber incident
